2022 EARLY VOTING NUMBERS SURPASS THOSE OF 2018

Early Voting for the 2022 Primary Election ended on Monday, August 1, 2022, with a record-breaking number of **4,418** electors participating, surpassing those of 2018. Of the 34, 697 registered Democrats territory wide, 13% participated in Early Voting. The break down per district is as follows: **St. Thomas - 2,182, St. Croix -2,131** and **St. John-105**.
