### 2022 PRIMARY ELECTION VOTING CENTERS RELOCATED

Supervisor of Elections, Caroline F. Fawkes, wishes to inform the public of recent changes to the locations of the 2022 Primary Election Voting Centers territory wide. Supervisor Fawkes stated, "due to unforeseen maintenance issues at the Bertha C. Boschulte Middle School on St. Thomas and the Claude O. Markoe Elementary School on St. Croix, changes were necessary to accommodate voters and poll workers." Voting Centers for the 2022 Primary Election are as follows:
